System Requirements

- QuarkXPress 8.x
- Mac OS X Tiger (10.4.2 or later), or Leopard (10.5.x)

How to Install, Update or Uninstall

Double-click the **OpenNow Pro 4.x Installer** icon and follow the on-screen instructions. You can use the same installer to install for the first time, update to a new version, or uninstall the software. If you are updating from an older version, the older XTension will be moved to the Trash once installation is complete.

By installing Badia OpenNow Pro, you agree to the Terms and Conditions listed in the License Agreement document.

IMPORTANT: Badia OpenNow 4.0 Pro may interfere with Quark’s EditOriginal XTension. You should manually disable or remove the file “EditOriginal.xnt” from your XTensions folder and restart QuarkXPress.

30-Day Trial Period and Activation

OpenNow Pro will run in trial mode when it’s first installed. You have 30 days to test-drive this product without activating it. To activate and unlock the usage restrictions, click the “**About**” button and then the “**Activate Now**” button. Simply follow the instructions shown on screen to complete the activation process. The number of licenses that you purchase determine the exact number of computers that you are allowed to activate this software.

User Guide

Badia OpenNow 4.0 Pro is an XTension that gives you access to complete picture information, with options for updating, revealing, changing preview resolution, and opening the image with its default application or any application you choose. Version 4.0 also lets you navigate through all the images contained in the document, without closing the OpenNow window.

To access the OpenNow Pro window, select a picture in the document and do one of the following:

- **Double-click** on it with the Picture Content Tool selected, or
- Right-click with your mouse and select **Badia OpenNow Pro**, or
- Select **Badia OpenNow Pro** from the **Style** menu.

The OpenNow Pro window displays the following information:

- **Spread and Image Number:** The spread number the picture is in, and the picture number. Click on the **Left** and **Right** arrows to navigate through all the images contained in the document.



- **Image Thumbnail:** A thumbnail of the picture.
- **Name:** The picture file name.
- **Path:** The file path. Select any entry from this pop-up menu to reveal any enclosing folder in the Finder.
- **Size:** The file size in Kb or Mb.
- **Scale:** The picture scaling within the picture box.
- **Format:** The image format (EPS, TIFF, etc.).
- **Model:** The image color model (RGB, CMYK, etc.)
- **Dimensions:** The picture width and height.
- **Dimensions Units Pop-Up:** Allows you to select the units used to represent the picture dimensions. Document units are those currently used in the document.
- **Resolution:** The picture resolution. Effective resolution, which takes into account scaling of the picture within the picture box, is shown in brackets.
- **Modified:** Date the picture was last modified.
- **Color Profile:** The image color profile, as reported by the Finder.
- **Status:** Status of this picture (OK, Modified, etc.)
- **Preview:** The preview resolution (low or high). Click the appropriate radio button to immediately change the preview resolution. (The “FullResPreview.xnt” XTension must be loaded for this feature to work.)
- **Open With:** The application name and its Finder icon to open this picture with (default application as reported by the Finder, or any application you choose from the Open With Pop-Up menu).
- **Open With Pop-Up Menu:** This menu contains the default application and a list of recently added applications. Select the “**Other...**” option to choose a new application to open this picture. A list of up to 30 recent applications is remembered by OpenNow, and will be saved in the OpenNow preferences file.
- **Always Open With This Application:** When you select an application other than the default application from the Open With Pop-Up menu, you can click this button to force OpenNow to open all subsequent pictures with this application, regardless of their default application. This takes effect until you quit QuarkXPress (or until you uncheck the button). Note: this feature **does not** change the Open With status of the image in the Finder.
- **Update Button:** Available only for pictures with Modified or Wrong Type status. Click to bring the link up to date.
- **Reveal in Finder Button:** Click to reveal the image in the Finder. Not available for Missing/No Disk File images.
- **Picture Usage/BigPicture Button:** Click to open the picture usage window (or the Badia BigPicture window if this XTension is present).
- **Open Now Button:** Click to open the picture with the application currently selected in the Open With Pop-Up menu.
- **About Button:** Click to see version and serial number information for the installed version of OpenNow Pro.

Preferences

Badia OpenNow Pro creates a preferences file (**<User Name>/Library/Preferences/Quark/QuarkXPress 8/Badia OpenNow Pro 4.0.prf**) to store the list of recent Open With applications and other preferences. Deleting this file will revert to defaults.
